# Under the agreement for 2015 Queens Beach State School will receive

### This funding will be used to

- Increase the percentage of students meeting the National Minimum Standard (NMS) in Year 3 Reading from 92.2% to 100% by 2016.
- Increase the percentage of students in upper two bands (U2B) in Year 3 Reading from 29% to 35% by 2016.
- Develop an Individual Learning Plan for students at or below NMS in Year 3 Reading.
- Increase the percentage of students in Year Prep to Year 3 achieving 'C or above' in English from 71.75% in 2014 to 85% in 2015.

### Our strategy will be to

Use a continuous process to assess students' current performance in Reading; teach to the needs of the students; and reassess students to monitor improvement via:-

- Short Term Data Cycle based upon Reading Comprehension.
- · Itemised Analysis of NAPLAN Reports in Reading and Writing.
- Sharratt and Fullan's 14 Parameters with major focus on Parameters 1 (Shared Beliefs and Understandings), 5 (Early and Ongoing Intervention), 8 (In-school Year Level/Subject Meetings), and 14 (Shared Responsibility and Accountability).
- Use of Hattie's High Yield Strategies of Direct/Explicit Instruction and Professional Development.
- Track students' Individual Learning Goals.
- Improve staff capability through focused Professional Development to enhance student performance in Reading.
