This funding will be used to


- Empower confident and creative lifelong learners to Grow, Achieve and Succeed.

- Strengthening the pedagogical framework by deepening staff knowledge of evidence-based approaches (Hattie/Sharratt and Fullen) that impact students' learning – The right approach at the right time.
- Providing intervention and extension for students to align the next steps in their learning.

Our school will improve student outcomes by

- Employing additional staff to embed inclusive practices to drive high performance and positive learning outcomes. (\$74000)
- Powering up the Early Years by providing all students a great start to school and track growth through the literacy continuum. (\$96000)
- Employing additional staff to enhance Literacy, Numeracy and Sustainability through a kitchen and garden program to unlock the power of learning through hands on and real-life investigations. (\$25000)
- Purchasing additional TRS for Developing Performance Plans, cover stations to drive improvement in teacher pedagogy and practice. (\$5000)
- Employing support staff to align resources and student support to the explicit improvement agenda. (\$41943)
